

CJ Craig v. Marcus Welby Timeline of Events

1991	Established doctor/patient relationship Dr. Welby and CJ
1992	CJ diagnosed with psoriatic arthritis
January 18, 2000	Southeastern IRB reviewed and approved Rapido protocol
April 11, 2000	Contract signed between Pharm and Dr. Welby for conduct of Rapido study in his office
April 4, 2000	Dr. Welby first suggested to CJ that she would be good candidate for Rapido study
May 3, 2000	Dr. Welby discontinued CJ's methotrexate in anticipation of participation in study
June 1, 2000	CJ received copy of consent form by mail
July 11, 2000	CJ signed informed consent – randomization occurred
July 14, 2000	First injection
July – Oct	Follow-up and injections continued per protocol
October 12, 2000	Office visit – Extended Treatment phase began; CJ randomized to low dose
Oct 12 – Dec 8	Follow-up and injections continued per protocol
Dec 8, 2000	CJ became worse when arthritis invaded lower spine
Dec. 21, 2000	Office visit – CJ withdrew from study and requested return to methotrexate
Dec. 27, 2000	Office visit at Dr. Welby's request – returned for final study blood draws and paperwork
January 3, 2000	Phone call from CJ to Dr. Welby's office requesting methotrexate; prescription called in and CJ re-started methotrexate
